ORDER


On March 25, 2026, this court issued an Order (doc. no. 66) granting plaintiffs' unopposed motion for preliminary approval of the parties' proposed class action settlement (doc. no. 65). In that Order, the court directed the parties to make several revisions to their proposed notices of class action settlement. On April 13, plaintiffs filed revised notices, however, the revised Long Form Notice did not fully cure the deficiencies identified in this court's prior Order.¹ On April 20, plaintiffs filed another Long Form Notice (doc. no. 70), which adequately addresses the court's concerns. Accordingly, the court directs class counsel to cause the Settlement Administrator to provide notice to the class members in substantially the form as doc. nos. 67 and 70 and to develop and maintain the settlement website as required under the Agreement.²

¹ As this court noted in its April 15 Order, the revisions to the Postcard Notice (doc. no. 67) are appropriate.

² If necessary, the parties may, by mutual agreement, make further revisions to the notice forms (doc. nos. 67 and 70) for the purposes of correcting clerical errors, inaccuracies, or formatting.

The court sets the following schedule for the deadlines relating to the notice process and final fairness hearing: The court shall hold a fairness hearing on **August 13, 2026, at 2:00p.m.** in Courtroom One of the United States District Court for the District of New Hampshire, 55 Pleasant Street, Concord, NH 03301. On or before **May 12, 2026**, the Settlement Administrator shall send notice to the class as outlined in the Agreement. The parties shall file any pleadings in support of final approval, including class counsel's application for attorney fees, litigation costs, and case contribution awards, no later than **June 14, 2026**. The last day to object to the settlement and to file a notice of intention to appear at the fairness hearing shall be **July 14, 2026**. The last day to file responses to objections and replies in support of final approval and attorney fees shall be **July 30, 2026**.
